

Palmerston North Life Member and former leading Central Squash Coach passes on

SquashGym Palmerston North life member and well known coach Bill Pye died on Wednesday, 19th October 2011 after a short illness.

Pye was the Palmerston North Club Captain in 1979-81 and President during Squash's hey days of 1984-85. He was awarded Life Membership in 1994.

However it is ultimately his coaching contribution for which he will be remembered. Part of the New Zealand Squash coaching structure for over 25 years, Pye was Central Districts head coach for over a decade. He coached and mentored many leading players in the Central Districts region and coached the 1984 Central Junior Boys team to a New Zealand team title.

Well into his 80's Pye kept in touch with the sport and was still coaching up until last year, passing on his knowledge to new club members and beginners.

A builder by trade, in later life he was actively involved as a volunteer at the Arohanui Hospice and was a supporter of Guide dogs for the New Zealand Foundation for the Blind.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

The year started with a bang with the World Women's Squash Teams championship being hosted in Palmerston North by SquashGym. This event brought most of the world's top women players to our district, congratulations to SquashGym on running a suburb event.

2011 has been a year with success on the court, internationally with Danielle Fourie representing NZ at the World Junior Girls Championship in both the individual & teams event held in Boston. This is quite a large achievement by Danielle and is a worthy reward for the many hours she has put in training to make the team. It has been some years since we have had a central player represent NZ at a world event. Dylan Tasker made the world junior boys squad who are training for the 2012 event. We wish him the best of luck for next year and hope he achieves his target of making the national team.

Nationally, district teams won the NZ Club Master Team Championship, the B Grade National SuperChamps and the F Grade National SuperChamps plus there were many other SuperChamps teams coming close to winning their respective titles.

Individually, Rodney Bannister won the NZ Masters 40+ age group against some very tough competition. Kaitlyn Watts won the NZ under 11 Girls national title; she is definitely a rising star. She is one to watch in years to come.

In our clubs we have had success regionally with Wanganui Squash Club winning Sport Wanganui Club of the Year. The club competed against all sports for this award; this was very well deserved by a club that has put a significant effort in this year.

Inter-district competition has been resurrected this year initially with a junior clash against Wellington. Thank you to Di Tasker who initiated and organised this event. The district is currently looking at clashes against Eastern and Wellington for next year in both the seniors and juniors.

Sharon Patterson along with host clubs ran and organised another successful Junior Players series this year, this competition is fantastic for the future of our sport and would like to encourage clubs to promote the series to all of their junior players.

In the coming year Central squash is host to the NZ Senior Championships at Kawaroa Park; this is held during their centennial year. The NZ Junior Age Group Championships are also being held in the district hosted by SquashGym.

Despite the on court success's this year, the Central Squash board has struggled due to lack of board members. We are entering another year with very people putting their hands up and I would like to encourage anybody who is interested in becoming part of the team to come forward.

Central Squash is not an organisation separate from squash clubs and players, you as the players and clubs in the district are Central Squash and decide how it is there to help you. The district hand in hand with the clubs has huge potential to grow Squash in the area. It only needs some people who love the sport.

Thank to the many volunteers at both club level and in the district without you there would not be any squash. I am excited by initiatives in squash all over our district by clubs and by Squash NZ and feel positive about the long term future of the game.

FINANCE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

2011 has been a very quiet year for Central squash. The year ended with a deficit of \$1328 in the accounts (2009 \$6,879 surplus) this was partly due to the fact that we wrote off the obsolete clothing this year, which in the past years has been the main amount of the stock on hand. Income dropped markedly this year so it was a reasonably satisfactory result. Unfortunately we received no grants this year which made it difficult for us. SNZ funding was for club development and the monies received were on paid to the clubs that had applied for the funds.

InspireNet chose not to renew their sponsorship in 2011 which meant that the InspireNet squad did not exist this year and the coaches count programme was provided on a smaller scale.

Our overall expenses dropped during the year which helped us to end the year with the small operating surplus. On a positive note we were able to contribute towards the travel costs for Danielle Fourie & Dylan Tasker, two of our up and coming juniors who were involved with National squads. We have also managed to further increase our cash reserves ending the year with \$72,653 in the bank (2010 \$66,000). We will need a reasonable amount of this heading into 2012 as sending a junior team to Auckland for Nationals in the middle of a rugby world cup was not a cheap undertaking, and with all three national events in our districts or neighbouring districts next year we will be doing our best to send teams to all of them.

Debtors collection is an issue that seems to trouble us every year. I must say that this year there has been a steady stream of funds coming in; most clubs seem to be managing. Once again a reminder that a monthly AP is often a good way to help cash flow, little & often, not one large lump sum.

This year I am recommending to the board that the affiliation fees be increased by 2.8% per SEM. Whilst this may seem a lot there has been no increase for the last four financial years, and with the trend over the last few years for the SEM numbers to drop by about 50 per year, even with the recommended increase we will still be collecting less income from affiliation fees in 2012 than before. As shown in the budget figures in the annual report, all things being equal the district will actually end up with a small operating deficit in 2012.

Have a merry xmas & festive season. We shall see you all on the squash courts in 2012.

ANNUAL REVIEW 2011

Thank you for electing Cotton Kelly to review the financial statements of Central Squash Association (Incorporated).

The review has now been completed and the signed review report and financial statements have been returned to your Finance Director.

The following matters / suggestions were identified during our review. We raise these for further consideration by the Board:

- The society's cheque account earns no interest income but held an average balance during the year of approximately \$21,000. At 3.5%, this equates to interest forgone of around \$700 per aroum.
- Progress (actual) against budget could be reported at each Board meeting and paid invoices tabled for inspection and ratified to improve monitoring and accountability.
- After recent Directors' resignations, three new Directors are required in order to complete a
 Board of five Directors (excluding the President) as required by the Constitution (paragraph
 9.2).
- The Board seek employment advice and review its position in respect of potential obligations it may have under the Holidays Act. A contingent liability disclosing a possible liability for annual leave has been included in notes to the financial statements (page 7).
- After resolving the above, that the secretary's contract be updated accordingly and signed off
 by both her and the society.

CONCLUSION

Please pass on my thanks to Jane for her excellent co-operation and support during the review.

Cotton Kelly is available again for the society's 2012 review, or audit if required.

Accountants Report to the Members of Central Squash Association (Incorporated)

We have reviewed the financial statements of Central Squash Association (Incorporated) on pages 1 to 7 for the year ended 30 September 2011 in accordance with the Review Engagement Standards issued by the New Zealand Institute of Chartered Accountants.

A review is limited primarily to enquiries of society personnel and analytical review procedures applied to financial data and thus provides less assurance than an audit. We have not performed an audit and, accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

In common with similar organisations, control over income prior to it being recorded is limited and there were no practical review procedures to determine the effects of this limitation.

Based on our review, other than the limitation identified above regarding the completeness of income, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying financial statements do not fairly reflect the financial position of Central Squash Association (Incorporated) as at 30 September 2011 and the results of its operations for the year ended on that date.



NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 SEPTEMBER 2011

STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Central Squash Association (Incorporated) is an incorporated society, registered under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908. The financial statements of the Central Squash Association (Incorporated) have been prepared in accordance with the Financial Reporting Act 1993

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Practice.

MEASUREMENT BASE

The accounting principles recognised as appropriate for the measurement and reporting of carnings and financial position on a historical basis are followed by the entity.

DIFFERENTIAL REPORTING

Central Squash Association (Incorporated) qualifies for differential reporting as it is not publicly accountable and there is no seperation between the owners and the governing body. Central Squash Association (Incorporated) has taken advantage of all available differential reporting exemptions

SPECIFIC ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The following specific accounting policies which materially affect the measurement of financial performance and the financial position have been applied

ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE

Accounts receivable are stated at their net realisable value.

INVENTORIES

Inventories are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, on a first in-first out basis

FIXED ASSETS

All fixed assets are recorded at cost less accumulated depreciation to date.

Depreciation has been provided at the maximum rates permitted by the Income Tax Act 1994

INCOME TAX

The society is exempt from income tax as an amateur sports body under Section CW 46 of the Income Tax Act 2007

CONDITIONAL GRANTS

Grants received are recognised as income unless the specific conditions attached to them are not met. In these cases the grants are shown as a liability until the conditions are met





GOODS AND SERVICES TAX

The financial statements have been prepared on a GST exclusive basis with the exception of accounts receivable and accounts payable which are shown GST inclusive

CONTINGENT LIABILITY

Central Squash Association (Incorporated) have an administrator employed under a contract for service. A potential liability for annual leave entitlements may exist for this employee

CHANGES IN ACCOUNTING POLICIES

There have been no changes in accounting policies during the year. All policies have been applied on a consistent basis with previous years.
